## Portable SW Antenna **ANT 60**

- The **SANGEAN ANT 60 Portable Short Wave Antenna** will improve the performance and reception of your **Short Wave Radio** and will easily outperform its built-in telescoping antenna. Its antenna wire may be extended to full 23 feet (7 meters) and when not in use it may be easily rewound into its case to fit neatly in your shirt pocket.
- The antenna is terminated with a 1/8" (3.5mm) Mini-Plug suitable for plugging directly into the **External Antenna Jack** of the **SANGEAN Models ATS 808,ATS 818CS,ATS 818,ATS 606** or any **Short Wave Radio** with a 1/8" (3.5mm) **External Antenna Jack**.
- If your Receiver does not have an 1/8" **External Antenna Jack** or has another type of jack, an adaptor plug is provided that plugs into the terminated antenna plug at the end of the antenna and is clipped on the telescoping antenna on your radio. Ideally suited for todays compact Shortwave Receiver, the **SANGEAN ANT 60** is a must wherever and Whenever you use your Shortwave Receiver.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- For best performance the antenna wire should be positioned as high as possible and fully extended if necessary. It may be supported by the carrying strap. If indoors locate some permanent object to attach the strap. If outdoors a tree branch, fence post or similar support may be used. **DO NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES USE A UTILITY POLE AS SUPPORT!** Avoid ANY area where live voltage may be present. In addition to the shock hazard live voltage may cause interference to your short wave reception.
- Pull out as much wire as it takes to reach your shortwave radio. Generally speaking, the longer the wire and the higher it is placed the better the reception.
- The slotted connector at the end of the adaptor plug snaps over anyone of the sections of the telescoping rod antenna built into your short wave Receiver. Make sure the clip is attached snugly. Shortwave signals will be transferred from the portable antenna to your radio through this connector. Clip may be squeezed together or spread apart slightly for best connection.
- When your are finished with the antenna. unsnap the connector from the rod antenna, unhook the carrying/hangup strap from the support and wind up the antenna wire into its housing in the direction indicated by the arrow using the convenient finger well on the side of the antenna housing.
